- Last semester's grades need to reflect at least a 3.0 GPA
- You must earn a minimum of 10 points from last semester's grades.
  - i. The first 4 points must be from List I
  - ii. The first 7 points (including the 4 points described above) must be from Lists I and II
  - iii. Remaining points may come from Lists I, II or III.
- You may use no more than 5 classes to qualify.
- Use the attached pages to complete your course list.

#### Also remember:

- Semester membership is based on work done in the *previous* semester.
- Hours are due the Friday we return from summer and winter break
- You must reapply and complete community service hours **each semester**.
- o Courses you may use are attached. They are divided into Lists I, II and III.

#### What to do after you complete your application:

- Start on your 6 hours of community service!
- You will only be notified if you do NOT qualify

- Take this paper to the CSF officers. The officers will check your transcript to ensure accuracy and make sure everything is filled out properly.
- Be sure to look out for announcements through **Remind** and **ONE**. 4.
