

CSF Website Information

To qualify for CSF membership this semester, follow these guidelines:

- Last semester's grades need to reflect at least a 3.0 GPA
- You must earn a minimum of 10 points from last semester's grades.
 - i. The first 4 points **must** be from List I
 - ii. The first 7 points (including the 4 points described above) must be from Lists I and II
 - iii. Remaining points may come from Lists I, II or III.
- **You may use no more than 5 classes to qualify.**
- Use the attached pages to complete your course list.

Also remember:

- Semester membership is based on work done in the *previous* semester.
- **Hours are due the Friday we return from summer and winter break**
- You must reapply and complete community service hours **each semester**.
- Courses you may use are attached. They are divided into Lists I, II and III.

What to do after you complete your application:

- Start on your 6 hours of community service!
- You will only be notified if you do NOT qualify
