## Schedule Change Requests

#### **Schedule Change Request Timeline:**

- Deadline <u>before</u> first day of school: August 10th at 3:30pm
  - o If students submit after August 10th, their request will be processed after August 16th.
- Deadline <u>after</u> school starts: August 30th at 3:30 pm
  - o Pick Elective: If this appears on your student's schedule, please go to the Counseling Office during the period that says "Pick Elective."
- Please note:
  - o Requesting a class change may change your student's schedule, such as changing multiple periods and teachers. Once changes are made, we cannot guarantee your original schedule.
  - o We are unable to honor requests for specific teachers and periods.





#### **Credits**


- Complete 230 Credits in 4 years
