College Prep Elective	1 year

Students must earn a "**C**" or better in A-G courses

  - Spell correctly
  - Proper capitalization
  - No nicknames
- Include your student ID number
- Use a personal email account
  - SMUSD email addresses will be deactivated after July
- Request an unofficial copy to be sent to you via email





- Is on a first come, first served basis


### Requirements:

  - Independent/private & Out of state school admissions requirements may vary
- UC's and CSU's are not requiring SAT or ACT scores
- Independent/Private & out of state school may require SAT/ACT scores (Do your research)
- **FOR ASSISTANCE**: Attend our workshops for additional support on completing your college applications!

## The Alliance (CSUSM)

- be enrolled in high school grades 9th 12th
- complete all A-G coursework required by CSU admission policies
- meet minimum CSU eligibility index requirements
- have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 upon graduation
- participate in and successfully pass the Early Assessment Program in their junior year in mathematics and English, or successfully complete additional coursework designed to build the appropriate skills and knowledge
- submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)

### **Student Athletes**

- If you plan on competing at the collegiate level, you must register with <u>NCAA</u> or <u>NAIA</u>
- Confirm that you are on track by taking courses that are <u>NCAA approved</u>
- Students must submit SAT/ACT scores
  - NCAA Eligibility Center Code: 9999
  - NAIA Eligibility Center Code: 9876


